

CHAPTER XVI

INSTRUCTIONS ISSUED BY COMMISSIONERS

350. Commissioners may, without previous reference to the Board of Revenue or Government, issue circular to their subordinates (1) dealing with routine matters, (2) calling attention to existing orders, and (3) giving effect to specific instructions of the Board or Government. A copy of each circular issued in respect of judicial matters and matters relating to the subjects controlled by the Board should be submitted to the Board for information and copies of circulars relating to other matters should be submitted to Government.
